### HAVE YOUR BREW AND EAT IT TOO AT THESE LAS VEGAS RESTAURANTS

**Believe it or not, beer isn't just for drinking—at least not in a city like Las Vegas. From a friendly game of beer pong to a delicious meal cooked in ale, the Strip's many bars and restaurants have truly redefined the way people can enjoy their favorite brew. Here are three places beer lovers frequent not only for their selection, but also their presentation**

#### BLONDIES SPORTS BAR & GRILL INSIDE THE MIRACLE MILE SHOPS AT PLANET HOLLYWOOD RESORT & CASINO

Not your average sports bar, Blondies offers beer drinkers a fun atmosphere in which to enjoy an ice-cold brew, complete with beer pong tables, waitresses clad in cheerleader uniforms and more than 60 big screen TVs. During its happy hour every Mon.-Fri. from 3-6 p.m., patrons can enjoy all-you-can-drink domestic drafts and well drinks for only \$20. As if that wasn't enough, beer fans can indulge in Blondies' Famous Beer Can Chicken—a whole rotisserie chicken cooked with a sweet BBQ Bud Light Lime sauce, then roasted on the grill until it's juicy and tender.

#### GORDON RAMSAY PUB & GRILL AT CAESARS PALACE

One expects perfection from TV's most temperamental chef and that's just what they get when dining at this English pub boasting more than 24 beers on tap plus 70 bottled selections. Guests can peruse the many choices on an iPad before feasting their eyes on the mouth-watering menu, which features several dishes that pair well with beer. Must-tries include the tasty English Ale Onion Soup, the grilled Hanger Steak and the filling Yorkshire Ale Batter Fish & Chips.

#### PUBLIC HOUSE AT THE VENETIAN

Offering guests a more sophisticated beer-drinking experience, this gastro-pub is home to one of Nevada's few beer cicerones eager to help patrons find a brew that's right for them. With more than 200 selections on the menu—including 24 beers on tap—even the most knowledgeable

beer aficionado may need a little help! Several of the dishes, such as the flavorful Deschutes Black Butte Porter-braised Short Rib with IPA-battered onion rings, are also made with beer. There's even Hoegaarden ice cream for dessert! Drink—err, eat up! 🍷
